A.J Gatzemeyer had a small bookcase in Arts & Crafts style. The wood was quarter sawn white oak.

Pekin He also had a pencil box. The lid was made of small pieces of cherry, maple, and walnut. The box was made from walnut.

Carl Palow had two stools that he made. The seat was oak and the legs were hickory.

Norm Bartlett had a scroll sawn Christmas ornament. There were 4 wooden ornaments and 9 poster board ornaments. The 4 pieces of wood and 9 layers of poster board were laminated together using packing tape. Norm uses packing tape to hold the assembly together and to provide lubricant for the scroll saw blade. The packing tape makes the scroll saw blade last longer and prevents burning of the wood.
