**MAIN PROGRAM** for the Jan meeting was Jayson Snyder who gave a presentation on the goods and services offered by the Wood Workers Shop.

Show and Tell:

Bill Goff showed an all wood Poinsettia Plant. The petals are pink ivory, the stem is yellow heart, the leaves are poplar, the pot is walnut, and the base is cherry. The finish is Tung Oil.







Vic MacDonald had a photo of a clock he made. The wood is pine with stained glass accents





John Freimuth described a paddle he made years ago. The blade is laminated hickory and spruce. The blade is extra big to give a good bite into the water.

Mark Padesky described a method he used to make a ½ inch square hole in a long board. The board was too long to support well on the drill press. Mark removed the bit from the chisel and drilled out the hole. He then made a handle to fit the chisel and drove the chisel into the walnut board using a wooden mallet.





Carl Palow brought a partially completed stool. He used hard maple for the seat and ash for the legs. He leaves the screw heads exposed so the customer can see how he constructed the stool.

Norm Bartlett evaluated different tapes for preventing burning when scroll sawing parts.

He used blue painters tape, Scotch tape, black plastic tape, and packing tape. Only the packing tape was put on both sides. Appears any type of tape will prevent burning.
