Of interest was the encouragement to take inventory of what you have. Take the time to look around your shop...look high and low. Clear out the scraps and/or junk. Consider storage cabinets on casters to roll under benches or in similar places. Use shelf boxes. If necessary, consider a basic storage location system. Typically, when it's out of sight, it can be out of mind as well and, there isn't just one way to do anything.

It was an interesting and thought provoking presentation.

For the March meeting I will be bringing in my Vacuum Press and associated items to do a presentation on the actual use of a vacuum press.
