Les Linton - Program - Veneer Softening and Flattening With a Bag Press

Well, I thought about writing a 5 page essay on how great the presentation was for March, but I thought instead I should simply list the formula for the softening liquid that I use. Please note that there are many different versions of this material so your use may require you to add or reduce ingredients as needed. The internet is a great source of material.

As many spray bottles are 32 oz, I used that as my base for quantities.

4 oz = 1 part.

Glycerin - Softening Agent 1-1/2 Parts = 6 oz

Water - Carrier 4 Parts = 16 oz

Glue, white or yellow - Sizing Agent - 1 Part = 4 oz

Denatured Alcohol, helps with evaporation - 1 Part = 4 oz

Glue is the variable. For open grained burls that will not be stained you can increase this if necessary, but for lighter tight grained veneer that you plan on staining. reduce or eliminate the glue to avoid issues with the veneer accepting stain.

For the April meeting Arborist, Brandon Dobnick, will do a presentation for the club on ways and means to utilized the resources local to us. You will be in awe at some of the slabs he has salvaged within a 30 mile radius of his home in Oswego, IL.
