**The Woodworker's Shop on Manito Rd., Pekin**

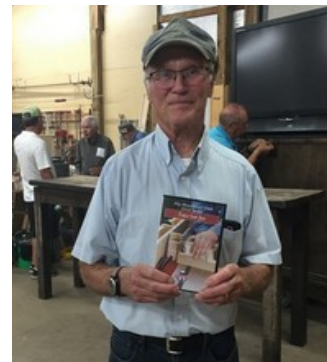

**Jason reclaimed the walnut from a old barn board that had to have been sawn around 1920. A little Danish oil brought out the colors of the contrasting woods.**



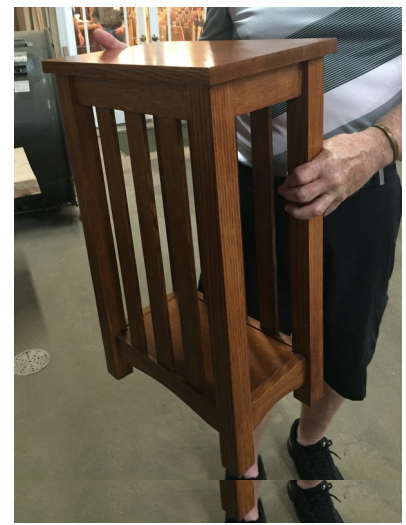

**Denny Dukes:** Denny crafted this Bonzai tree on a slab. It's beauty is in it's simplicity.





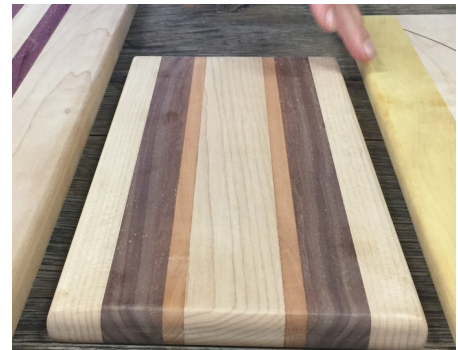
