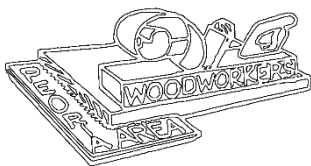
Old Business: A special thank you to all who participated in last months box program.

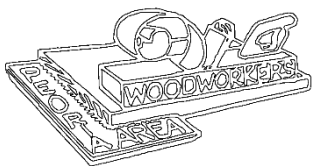
Segmented Turning Fixtures and Methods Brian Berchtold

Carl showed to of his turned “threaded lid” boxes. One in Maple and Walnut and the other in Maple and Paduch. Accuracy on the threads is critical.



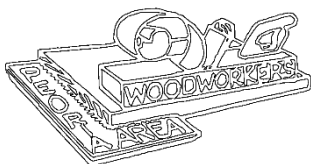
Tom Robertson

Jake brought in a metal Fillister plane he had acquired and is in the process of restoring it.



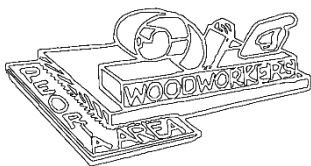
Tom Fidler

Larry Coggins

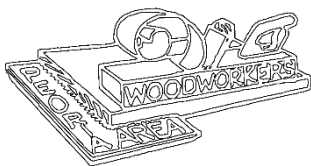
Larry was able to bring in a small top that he turned. Pull the string and it seems to spin forever.

After many years of the Tormek not getting used because it was under the bench Les finally built a wheeled cart so it will stay accessible. Will that help ??



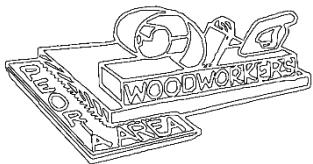

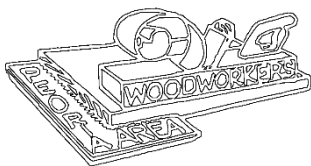
