Gary, one of our newest members brought in a piece that he has had around for quite some time. A bark on cottonwood wood spirit. Nicely done.








#### Mark Padesky





Time brought in pictures of two beautiful pieces he did for his Church. A lot of time and effort (and wood) to build this cross and the Alter rail on the next page.









