**New Business:** After much discussion meeting plans were set for the remainder of the year.


**September:** Fixtures and Jigs that you have built for use in your shop. Draw an entry for the Joint Challenge.






## **Scrapers and Planes Carl Miller**


## Les Linton

Lee became even more creative and built a curved lamp utilizing led lights.








# Vic McDonald

Norm brought in a scroll sawn deer of Baltic Birch.








# Dan Withrow

## Brian Berchtold


Brian brought in an inlaid pen and discussed the method used for this process.

Mark brought in three cribbage boards that he made and went over how he used a drill template in the build.








# Bill Wiese

Bill's drawer construction shows the quality and detail of this assembly.





June – Turned Project. Again, any size or shape. Exotic Segmented Bowl or a simple Pen or Bottle Stopper.


August - Games/Toys. This could be parts of Scroll Saw projects. Cars, Trains, Board Games or Puzzles.


