The \$25 Show & Tell gift card was won by Les Linton.

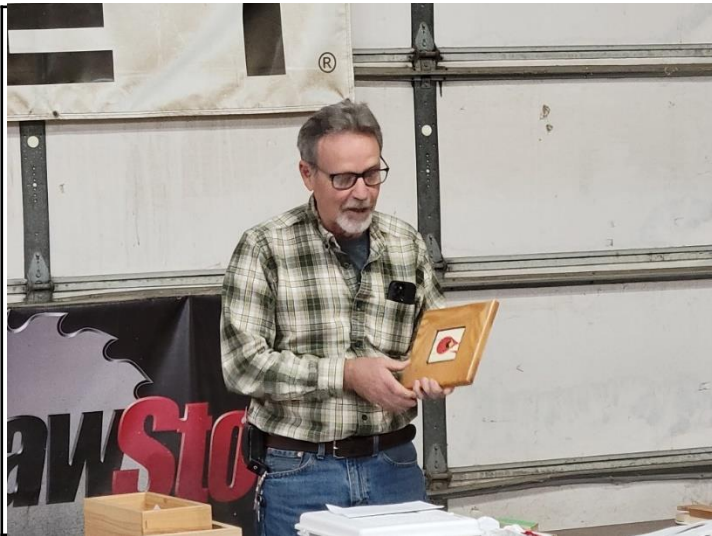
The \$35 Attendance gift card was won by Matt Wiegand.

Justin's joint was a dovetail lap joint



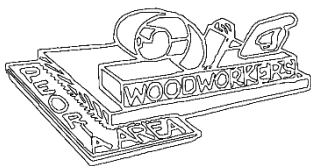

Russ's made this "window frame" with his joint.

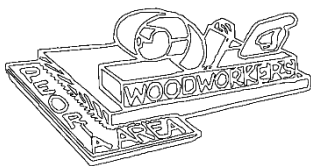

Marty's second joint was a knuckle joint.



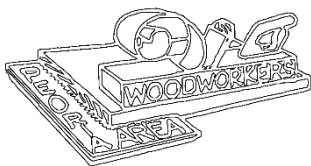

Dan's joint was a cogged joint.



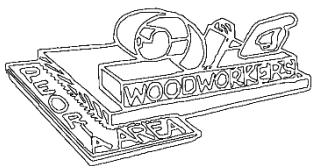
